Band Registration (Everything Day) - Friday, August 1

Our Band Registration will take place in the BMS Band Hall on **Friday, August 1** from 9:00am-6:00pm (come-and-go): **click here to see a map to the BMS Band Hall**.

Bring your instrument and all supplies/materials to have it checked over by a director to make sure you have everything ready to go for the start of school. Please plan on 30-45 minutes to visit all of the stations. *Please bring back all instruments that were checked out over the summer.*

All students and one parent will need to attend in order to:

- · Order and pay for uniform shirts
- · Pay for school-owned instrument usage fees
- Take care of all paperwork
- Locker checkout
- Register as a district volunteer to chaperone
- Have directors check over supplies and materials

Teacher & Student Shared Responsibilities

In the Belton MS Band, we form a partnership between teacher and student where *both* share responsibility in their musical development. Our team of teachers include middle school directors, private lesson instructors, high school directors, and

even hired clinicians, masterclass teachers, and adjudicators. We also strive to communicate and produce strong partnerships with parents since their support is vital in their student's growth.

To that end, we as the teaching team provide Introduction, Comprehension, and Demonstration to students for their instruction. However, <u>each student has a responsibility as well to facilitate</u>

Repetition in the form of practicing daily for at least 25 minutes, 5 days per week.

This means that <u>instruments go home everyday</u> to practice the concepts, patterns, and music that we go over daily in class. This leads to student Mastery of their music and ultimately of their instrument. <u>Students have homework everyday in Band</u> as they practice their instrument in preparation for performances and to continue their musical growth. 
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Region Bootcamp - Saturday, August 16


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


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Jazz Book & Uniform Shirt Needed
