



Holiday Concert - THIS WEDNESDAY!

Attached below please find all the details for our upcoming Holiday Concert and the map of Belton High School. The Band Hall will close at 4:30pm on Wednesday and students are responsible for



taking their instrument, music binder, and sticks/mallets to the PAC. This concert performance serves as our Semester Exam and is *critical* to their success as a musician. This free concert is open to all friends and family members and students can invite as many people as they would like to watch them perform.

Beginners will have 2 required after school rehearsals on Monday & Tuesday, December 15 & 16 from 4-5pm in the Band Hall. Please pick up your student in the parent drop-off loop by 5pm both days. Beginners will need to arrive at the Belton HS PAC by 5:50pm and be seated ready to warm up on stage no later than 6:00pm. We will also give parents an opportunity for a quick "photo-op" on stage with your student right before we start the concert at 6:30pm!

All students will wear their band uniform and instrument cases should stay in vehicles or with parents at their seats in the PAC. We would like for students to stay to watch the rest of the concert so they can support all band students performing and display proper concert etiquette. 

Teacher & Student Shared Responsibilities

In the Belton MS Band, we form a partnership between teacher and student where *both* share responsibility in their musical development. Our team of teachers include middle school directors, private lesson instructors, high school directors, and

even hired clinicians, masterclass teachers, and adjudicators. We also strive to communicate and produce strong partnerships with parents since their support is vital in their student's growth.

To that end, we as the teaching team provide Introduction, Comprehension, and Demonstration to students for their instruction. However, <u>each student has a responsibility as well to facilitate</u>

<u>Repetition in the form of practicing daily for at least 25 minutes, 5 days per week.</u>

This means that <u>instruments go home everyday</u> to practice the concepts, patterns, and music that we go over daily in class. This leads to student Mastery of their music and ultimately of their instrument. <u>Students have homework everyday in Band</u> as they practice their instrument in preparation for performances and to continue their musical growth. Reach out to a director if you would like more information on how to better help and support the musical growth of your student.

Instruments Come Home Daily!

Students should take their instruments home daily and we <u>expect</u> them to practice 5 days a week for at least 25 minutes. Students may also practice before school in the Band Hall starting at 7:30am every school day.

Parents, we implore you to help set up a consistent practice routine at home for your student. Students will not improve their musical skills on their instrument without practice outside of regular class time. The directors, we will teach your student what and how to practice, but we need your help in establishing when and how much they practice. The more they practice, the better they will get faster. Spring Sectional Survey

Please use this form to fill out your student's availability after school Monday-Friday from 4:00-5:00pm starting the week of January 12 until March 6. We want to avoid athletic games, meets, tournaments, and matches. We have already worked out a plan with all coaches to share students when they participate in athletic practices. All students in both Symphonic Band and Wind Ensemble are required to attend one sectional per week from 4:00-5:00pm for a grade.

Students are expected to "Be Punctual" and arrive seated with all materials and ready to rehearse at 4pm sharp or their grade will be affected. Students 1-5 minutes late will have their sectional grade reduced to an 85. Students who are late 5-15 minutes will have their grade reduced to a 70. Students arriving more than 15 minutes late will receive a 50.



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


